St. Tarcisus Award Campout

Inspired by the International Eucharistic Congress held in Philadelphia in 1976, and its theme "Hungers of Mankind," the St. Tarcisus Award was developed to make Church more important in your life. It increases your awareness of God's presence in your life and especially in the Holy Eucharist.



The program is open to any registered male or female Catholic Scout, age 11-18, plus adult Scouters. Adult Scouters are encouraged to attend.

The program begins with registration at 6 PM Friday and an evening session that includes a candle-light outdoor Stations of the Cross. The fun-filled weekend concludes with a celebration of Mass on Sunday morning.

Cost: \$33.00 per person, which includes all program materials, the Award medal, a commemorative patch, an evening cracker barrel and refreshments. Make checks payable to Monmouth Council Catholic Committee on Scouting.

Bring: A Bible, Class A Scout Uniform, appropriate camping clothes for the weekend, including rain gear and a can of food. Campsites will be assigned. Troops will camp as units at Quail Hill and be responsible for cooking their own meals. Individual Scouts that wish to participate will be formed into a provisional troop. The number of participants will be limited to 20 and Scouts and Scouters will be registered on a first come basis. All individuals must pre-register. There will be no registration at the campout.

3. Scouts who wish to come as individuals should request a "Provisional Camper" registration form. Deadline for filing request is September 6, 2004.

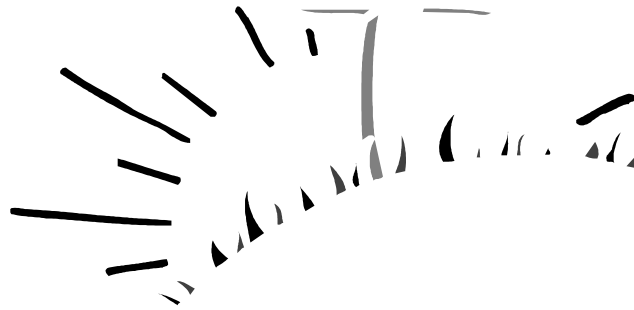
"49th Annual Retreat"
